

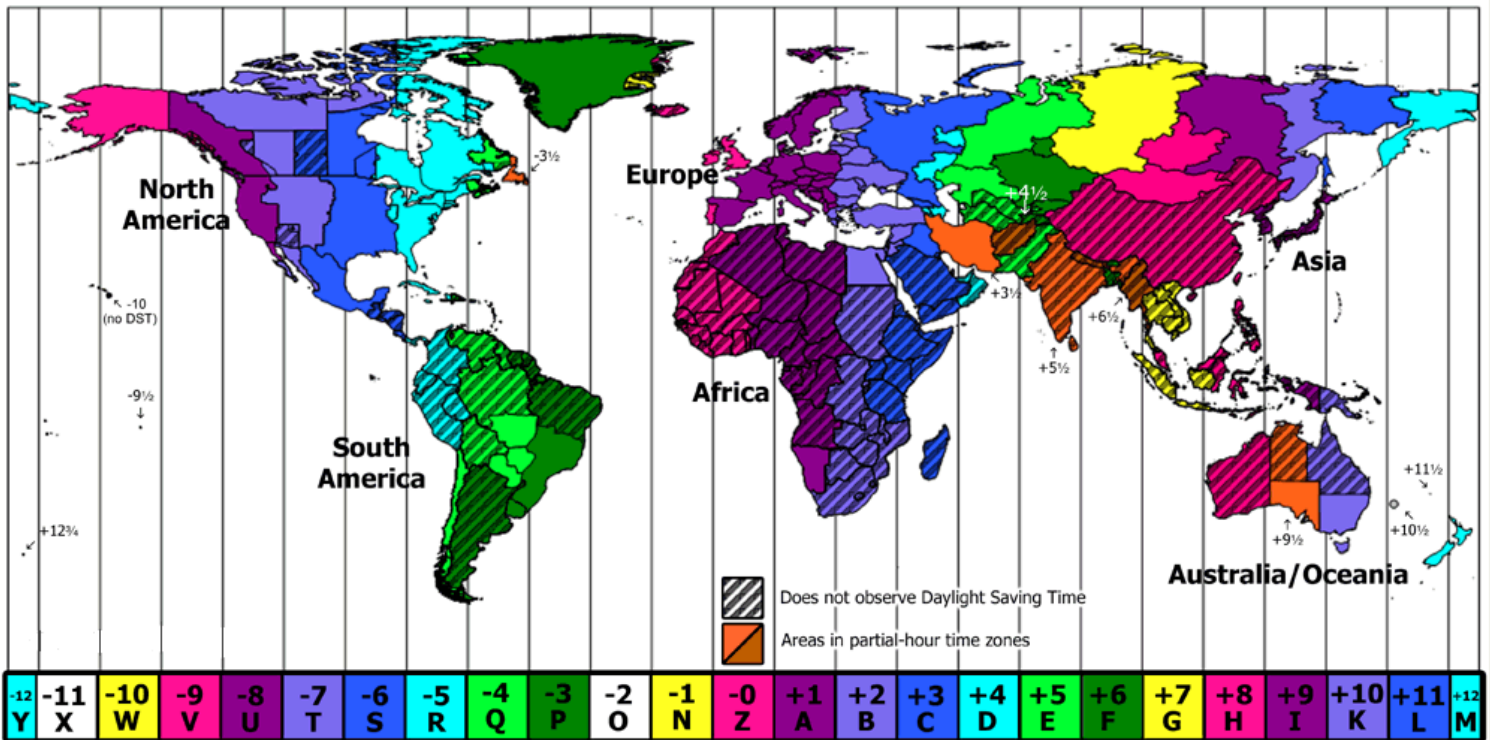

Time Zones

The map below shows how the world is split into different time zones.

Traditionally, time was told in relation to the meridian line at Greenwich, and known as Greenwich Mean Time (GMT). Since 1972 the term UTC (Coordinated Universal Time) has been used.
